

LETTER OF INTENT

between

The University of Rwanda  
College of Education

The University of Koblenz-Landau  
Fachbereich 5 Erziehungswissenschaften

and

The Erziehungswissenschaftliches Fort- und Weiterbildungs-  
institut der Evang. Kirchen in Rheinland-Pfalz (EFWI).

Following consultations between representatives of the above-mentioned Higher Learning Institutions in Rwanda and Rheinland-Pfalz (Germany), it has been agreed that the present letter of intent be developed. The purpose of the letter is to promote co-operation in teaching and research in the areas of special needs/inclusive education and related services between the University of Rwanda (College of Education), the University of Koblenz-Landau (Fachbereich 5 Erziehungswissenschaften), and the Erziehungswissenschaftliches Fort- und Weiterbildungsinstitut der Evang. Kirchen in Rheinland-Pfalz (EFWI).

The three institutions will make every reasonable effort to collaborate in academic accomplishments through research, community service and teaching activities, and do agree to enter into negotiations on the following general areas of co-operation:

- I. Joint research activities,
- II. Exchange of academic materials and academic publications,
- III. Exchange of faculty members for research, lectures and discussions,
- IV. Exchange of graduate and undergraduate students for studies and research,
- V. Co-organisation and participation in lectures, seminars and conferences,
- VI. Co-operation in academic administration issues.
- VII. Co-operation in the development of infrastructure and equipment developments,
- VIII. Capacity building and academic program development

The themes of joint activities, the conditions for utilising the results achieved and the arrangements for visits and exchanges and other forms of co-operation will be negotiated separately for each specific case by the concerned parties. Either party can terminate the negotiations for emerging reasons.

It is understood that all financial arrangements between the two Universities and the EFWI will be negotiated separately by concerned parties.

It is also understood that the implementation of the agreement will commence upon the signatory by the three parties, and that it will be valid for five years subject to revision or modification through mutual consent. The possibility and terms of renewal of any agreement will be discussed by the representatives of both Universities and the EFWI within six months prior to its termination.




